

**YOUTH TO YOUTH GRANT APPLICATION

Dear Potential Grant Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the Youth To Youth (Y2Y) program. Our program awards mini-grants ranging from \$50 - \$500 to youth providing a community service or event in La Porte County. **Grant submission deadline is Friday, March 9, 2018.**

Your fully completed grant application must be submitted by the deadline date either by email as a PDF attachment to monica@leadershiplaportecounty.com, fax to 219-379-5657 or mail to Leadership La Porte County (809 Washington Street Suite B, La Porte, IN 46350) to be considered for a grant. The application must be completed and presented by a minimum of one youth with the support of a minimum of one adult. Sponsoring youth must present the application to the Y2Y Team for consideration. Presentations should be a maximum of 10 minutes, will consist of a conversation with applicant(s) and Y2Y Team. The presentation does not need to involve unnecessary materials such as handouts, power point, poster board, etc.

Grant recipients will be notified in advance for an application presentation to the Y2Y team. The Y2Y team may require additional components to your project for approval (i.e. matching funding, a partnering organization from the community, etc.). All projects must be completed by the deadline date indicated on the application proposal. A brief follow up report with accompanying photographs is required.

YOUTH TO YOUTH GRANT APPLICATION INFORMATION

What is being offered?

Grants ranging from \$50 to \$500 for youth-led projects that put the ideas and energies of young people in action to address community needs.

What can grant money be used for?

Y2Y Grants can be used for direct operation of a project, transportation, and/or recognition of project participants. Recognition costs cannot exceed 15% of the grant award.

What can grant money not be used for?

Y2Y Grant monies CANNOT be used for overhead costs, religious purposes, salaries or wages, as a direct donation to another organization or purchase of capital items.

Who is eligible?

Youth in grades 5th – 11th during the school year that project will take place.

How do we apply?

Complete the attached Y2Y Grant Application by the indicated deadline. Submit to Y2Y Team by email as a PDF attachment to monica@leadershiplaportecounty.com, fax to 219-379-5657 or by mail to Leadership La Porte County (809 Washington Street Suite B, La Porte, IN 46350). You will be contacted for a date to present to the Y2Y Team.

How do we prepare for a Y2Y Team presentation?

The Y2Y Team will interview each team that submits eligible and qualified proposals. Screenings occur on a weekday and are allotted 10 minutes maximum. You will be given notice of your date for presentation. It is not necessary to prepare power point presentations or excessive handouts. The Y2Y team is composed of Leadership La Porte County Youth who have been trained in the grant cycle process. The team will look for:

- Youth involved with a variety of roles and responsibilities.
- Creative solutions to community needs.
- Plans that are cost effective for the goal(s) identified.
- Networks within the community that may include additional funding.
- Reflection activities to assist youth to gain insight about how to make a difference.
